EXCURSION

Embrace the Wild within!

The Wild Ed Experience is our most popular living lesson and takes place at the Australian Wildlife Sanctuary.

In order for students to be immersed in nature, our experience is conducted outside in a beautiful natural setting and within our education centre.

Your students will have the opportunity to encounter and interact with a range of native wildlife.

This interactive experience focuses on a wide range of educational content including adaptations, habitat, conservation, and threatened species.

Package includes:

- Kangaroo, Emu, and Swan Feeding
- Guided Woodlands tour including Quokkas, wombats, wallabies, and birds
- Reptile encounters including pythons, lizards, and dragons
- Meet a Saltwater Crocodile
- Wildlife presentations including Tawny Frogmouth, Ring-tailed Possums, Sugar Gliders, Bush-stone Curlews and Rainbow Lorikeet
